

ORDINANCE NO. 4495

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SPEED OF VEHICLES ON ROSS ROAD LOCATED IN SECTIONS 19 AND 24, TOWNSHIP 17 NORTH, RANGES 11 AND 12 WEST, BOSSIER PARISH, LOUISIANA, AND PROVIDING THE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Bossier Parish Police Jury in regular and legal session convened on this 17th day of July, 2013, that from and after the effective date of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate or drive a vehicle upon Ross Road, located off Jamerson Road in Sections 19 and 24, Township 17 North, Ranges 11 and 12 West, Bossier Parish, Louisiana, in excess of twenty-five (25) miles per hour.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that any person found guilty of violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined a sum not to exceed Five Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$500.00), or imprisoned for not more than thirty (30) days, or both.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

The ordinance was offered by Mr. Brotherton, seconded by Mr. Shewmake. Upon unanimous vote, it was duly adopted on this 17th day of July, 2013.
