

ORDINANCE NO. 4530

AN ORDINANCE TO OFFICIALLY POST THE LINTON ROAD BRIDGE OVER BLACK BAYOU, BOSSIER PARISH, LOUISIANA, AS TO THE LOAD CARRYING CAPABILITIES OF SAID BRIDGE STRUCUTRE; AND PROVIDING THE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Bossier Parish Police Jury in regular and legal session on this 16<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2014, that from and after the effective date of this ordinance the Linton Road Bridge over Black Bayou is hereby officially posted as to load carrying capabilities, as follows:

<u>Location:</u>	<u>Load Posting:</u>
Linton Road Bridge over Black Bayou	25 – 40 tons

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that any person found guilty of violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined a sum not to exceed Five Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$500.00), or imprisoned for not more than thirty (30) days, or both.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

The ordinance was offered by Mr. Brotherton, seconded by Mr. Plummer. Upon vote, it was duly adopted on this 16<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2014.
