

ORDINANCE NO. 4537

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND BOSSIER PARISH ORDINANCE NO. 3908 OF 2003, WHICH ADOPTED A UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE FOR THE BOSSIER CITY-PARISH METROPOLITAN PLANNING COMMISSION AND THE PARISH OF BOSSIER, LOUISIANA, BY CHANGING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION OF A 9.5 ACRE TRACT OF LAND, MORE OR LESS, LOCATED AT 4500 BENTON ROAD, BOSSIER CITY, BOSSIER PARISH, LA, FROM R-A, RESIDENTIAL-AGRICULTURE DISTRICT, TO B-3, GENERAL BUSINESS DISTRICT, FOR A MULTI-USE RETAIL CENTER

BE IT ORDAINED by the Bossier Parish Police Jury in regular and legal session convened on this 4<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2014, that Ordinance No. 3908 of 2003 (Unified Development Code) of the Police Jury of Bossier Parish, is hereby amended to change the zoning classification of a 9.5 acre tract of land, more or less, located at 4500 Benton Road, Bossier City, Bossier Parish, LA, from R-A, Residential-Agriculture District, to B-3, General Business District, for a multi-use retail center.
