

ORDINANCE NO. 4859

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SPEED OF VEHICLES ON WEST LINTON ROAD IN ITS ENTIRETY, LOCATED BETWEEN FAIRBURN AVENUE AND PALMETTO ROAD, IN SECTIONS 16 AND 17, TOWNSHIP 19 NORTH, RANGE 13 WEST, BOSSIER PARISH, LA, TO 30 MILES PER HOUR, AND PROVIDING THE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Bossier Parish Police Jury in regular and legal session convened on this 15<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2021, that from and after the effective date of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate or drive a vehicle upon West Linton Road in its entirety, located between Fairburn Avenue and Palmetto Road, in Sections 16 and 17, Township 19 North, Range 13 West, Bossier Parish, LA, in excess of thirty (30) miles per hour.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that any person found guilty of violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined a sum not to exceed Five Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$500.00), or imprisoned for not more than thirty (30) days, or both.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

The ordinance was offered by Mr. Rodgers, seconded by Mr. Marsiglia. Upon unanimous vote, it was duly adopted on this 15<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2021.
