

ORDINANCE NO. 4860

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 122, ARTICLE III, SECTION 122-73 OF THE BOSSIER PARISH CODE OF ORDINANCES BY ADDING SUBSECTION (E) COUNTRY PLACE UTILITIES MONTHLY PENALTY POLICY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Bossier Parish Police Jury in regular and legal session on this 15th day of September, 2021, that Chapter 122, Article III, Section 122-73 of the Bossier Parish Code of Ordinances, be and is hereby amended to add Subsection (E) as follows:

Section 122-73. Consolidated Waterworks/Sewerage District No. 1 Fees and Penalties

Section 122-73 (E) is hereby added as follows:

(E) Country Place Utilities Monthly Penalty Policy

(1) The Consolidated Waterworks/Sewerage District No. 1 of the Parish of Bossier office bills and receives payments for Country Place Utilities. On the second of each month, a late penalty will be applied to customer accounts that are delinquent. This penalty is five percent (5%) of the total bill for the month. The Consolidated Waterworks/Sewerage District No. 1 of the Parish of Bossier office will run a late penalty report on the 1st of the month which will show the total amount of penalties charged in the previous month. The Consolidated Waterworks/Sewerage District No. 1 of the Parish of Bossier office will then split the total amount of the penalties paid. Consolidated Waterworks/Sewerage District No. 1 of the Parish of Bossier will keep fifty percent (50%) and Country Place Utilities will be sent fifty percent (50%). The Consolidated Waterworks/Sewerage District No. 1 of the Parish of Bossier will then email the report to Country Place Utilities for their records. The Consolidated Waterworks/Sewerage District No. 1 of the Parish of Bossier supervisor will then send a check to Country Place Utilities for their penalty portion. This will be done every month and sent to Country Place Utilities.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that if any provisions or items of this ordinance or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, items, or applications, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared severable.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinance in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

The ordinance was offered by Mr. Rimmer, seconded by Mr. Gray. Upon unanimous vote, it was duly adopted on this 15th day September, 2021.
