

ORDINANCE NO. 5028

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SPEED OF VEHICLES ON FRANK STATON BOULEVARD LOCATED IN SECTIONS 17 AND 18, TOWNSHIP 18 NORTH, RANGE 11 WEST, BOSSIER PARISH, LOUISIANA, AND PROVIDING THE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Bossier Parish Police Jury in regular and legal session convened on this 18th day of September, 2024, that from and after the effective date of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate or drive a vehicle upon Frank Staton Boulevard located in Sections 17 and 18, Township 18 North, Range 11 West, Bossier Parish, Louisiana, in excess of thirty-five (35) miles per hour.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that any person found guilty of violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined a sum not to exceed Five Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$500.00), or imprisoned for not more than thirty (30) days, or both.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

The ordinance was offered by Mr. Benton, seconded by Mr. Brotherton. Upon unanimous vote, it was duly adopted on this 18th day of September, 2024.
